

Peacemaking Workshop 2009

Anna Baltzer is a 29 -year-old Jewish American Columbia graduate, Fulbright scholar, author, and the granddaughter of Holocaust refugees.

As a volunteer with the International Women's Peace Service, Baltzer documents human rights abuses in the West Bank and supports Palestinian-led nonviolent resistance to the Occupation. When not in Palestine, Baltzer spends most of her time on tour with her acclaimed presentation, "Life in Occupied Palestine: Eyewitness Stories & Photos," and her popular full-color book, 'Witness in Palestine: A Jewish American Woman in the Occupied Territories.'

Anna will tell stories and show slides recounting first-hand experiences with the conflict while living with Palestinians in the West Bank.
